Quilted Memories

Quilted Memories are quilts made from photos transferred to fabric, t-shirts and sweatshirts, baby clothing or even pieces of clothing cut into various shapes to piece into a quilt.

- Decide which type of memory quilt you would like to create for your loved one.
- Determine the theme (either color and/or hobby) or career
- Determine a size. Throw, twin, queen or even larger is possible.

It takes approximately six weeks to think, create and quilt such a memory for your loved one.



Memory Quilt Details

Size Options

Throw size \$175.00 and up
(50" x 60" to 60" x 60")

*9-12 t-shirts

Twin size \$225.00 and up
(63" x 87")

*20-30 t-shirts

Queen size \$300.00 and up
(84" x 92")

*20-29 t-shirts \$400.00

*30-39 t-shirts \$600.00

*40-49 t-shirts \$800.00

Prices do not include materials. Sashing, borders, batting and backing need to be purchased.
